

Francis M Hamblin 1839-1881

Francis Hamblin was born to Isaiah and Daphne Haynes Hamblin in Franklin Wisconsin on November 17, 1839. He and his brother Frederick were very close growing up and into adulthood. He was also Jacob Hamblin's younger brother.

After the hardships of crossing the plains his family arrived in the Salt Lake Valley in 1860. From there he settled with his family n Tooele, Utah.



There were many skirmishes with the Indian people in this valley. n the spring of 1856, he was called as a missionary to the Southern Indian Mission. During his time on the Santa Clara, he accompanied Jacob on several expeditions, trying to make peace and friendly relations with the Indian Tribes.

Francis married Arminda Crow October 31, 1859. He died in Kanab, Utah on July 30, 1881.
